





2 Functions and features


The optical angle sensor detects objects and materials without contact and indicates their presence by a switching signal.

3 Installation



- Secure the optical angle sensor (OPL...) to a bracket.

4 Operating and display elements




- 1: LED yellow function check

5 Electrical connection

- !** The unit must be connected by a qualified electrician.
- The national and international regulations for the installation of electrical equipment must be adhered to.
 - Ensure voltage supply to EN 50178, SELV, PELV.
- The following indications apply if there is a UL listing mark on the product:
- For use in NFPA 79 applications only. Adapters providing field wiring means are available from the manufacturer. Refer to manufacturers information.
 - The device shall be supplied from an isolating transformer having a secondary Listed fuse rated
 - a) max 5 amps for voltages 0...20 Vrms (0...28.3 Vp) or
 - b) 100/Vp for voltages of 20...30 Vrms (28.3...42.4 Vp).
- Disconnect power.
- Connect the unit as follows:

6 Operation

- ▶ Check whether the unit operates correctly.
- > The yellow LED is lit when the output is switched.

7 Maintenance, repair, disposal

- ▶ Keep the lens of the sensor free from soiling.
- ▶ For cleaning do not use any solvents or cleaning agents which could damage the lens.
- ▶ After use dispose of the unit in an environmentally friendly way in accordance with the applicable national regulations.

Faulty sensors must only be repaired by the manufacturer.
